We had a great day at this year's Dearne Community Arts' Festival on Saturday 25th Sept at Astrea Academy Dearne in Goldthorpe.





Altogether there were 446 people at the event, 377 attending and 69 taking part. This is the largest attendance we've ever had and reflects the importance of creativity in the Dearne area and how people are desperate to regain some kind of normality after so long apart and in isolation.

One of our exhibitors (Jeanette Heavey, a lady in her 80s) told us that 'art kept me sane during lockdown', and there was clear evidence through all the exhibitions, displays and performances of the vital role the arts play in health and wellbeing.
